



# FUNDRAISING

## POLICY

### Rationale:

- We are committed to raising additional funds in order to enhance the teaching and learning programs of the college and improve college facilities.

### Aims:

- To actively seek to raise monies outside those provided by the Student Resource Package (DEECD) with the explicit intention of improving student outcomes.

### Implementation:

- The college will appoint a Fundraising Manager, who will be responsible for seeking opportunities to raise additional funding for the community.
- All fundraising opportunities will be vetted and approved by School Council prior to commencement of activity.
- The Fundraising Manager will report to School Council on a monthly basis.
- The Fundraising Manager will seek appropriate permissions with relevant outside authorities, adhering to requirements of by-laws and other legal obligations.
- Charitable fund-raising will be treated separately and will be organised either through the Student Representative Council or through independent application to School Council.
- The Fundraising Manager will ensure that monies raised by fundraising are accounted for on a regular basis. The Business Manager will keep appropriate records for report to Council.

### Evaluation:

- This policy will be reviewed as part of the college's three-year review cycle.
